Policy Responses to Climate Change There are two main policy responses to climate change: mitigation and adaptation. The overall goal of adaptation is to reduce the vulnerability of communities and increase their resilience to the adverse effects of climate change. It is easy to see how the protection of heritage against the negative impacts of climate change immediately relates to climate change adaptation. Adaptation speaks to the vulnerability and resilience of cultural heritage, ensuring that as climate change speeds up and amplifies the dynamism of the cultural landscape, heritage conservationists will remain able to "manage" static remains in a dynamic landscape. 59 Mitigation and adaptation go hand-in-hand as a two-pronged approach in managing the problem of climate change.
