1. Proximity Searching \bigcirc

Use proximity searching in any HeinOnline database to find specific words you wish to find in a given proximity to one another. To conduct a proximity search, use the tilde symbol, ~, at the end of a phrase. For example, use the **Full Text** tab in the Law Journal Library and search for "net neutrality regulation"~10.



2. Searching in the Federal Register $\exists \dot{Q}$

If you are searching for a change that was made on a specific day in the Federal Register, but you're not sure where the change would have fallen, you can conduct a search using the date. For example, use the advanced search box:

This search will return results in the Federal Register from March 4, 1975 that have both "federal railroad administration" and "appendix d" in the text.

3. Cumulative Contents 📙

Legislative histories found in HeinOnline's U.S. Federal Legislative History Library are comprised of a number of documents ranging from one or two to hundreds, which can be overwhelming to browse through. When clicking on the publication title of a legislative history, users have the ability to view the Cumulative Contents. This allows users to browse and scroll through all documents in all volumes. 4. Sources of Compiled Legislative Histories

Example: Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (P.L. 111-148)

Begin by <u>browsing by Congress</u>. Locate the 111th Congress and then find the Public Law number. Then, click on the name of the act.

5. Finding Citation Formats

Located above the table of contents of any document in HeinOnline is the <u>Cite button</u>. This tool provides the document's citation in multiple citation formats, including:

- Canadian Guide to Uniform Legal Citation (McGill Guide)



6. More Like This 🕇

<u>More Like This</u> uses a program that finds "interesting words" in an article, as determined by an algorithm that analyzes the article's text. Review the list of similar articles and adjust the boost factor on the interesting words as determined by the *More Like This* algorithm, or enter new terms to change the scope of the results.





7. Searching by Topic 🖑

Search for articles by topic using the <u>Advanced Search</u> option in the Law Journal Library. Browse through the listed topics or search for a specific topic of interest. Users can select multiple topics.
