






Military and Government




Indigenous Peoples of the Americas

This update is simply to give this essential resource and its tools a more appropriate name.



March 2021 | New Subcollection


- Welsh Legal History Society publications have been added as a new subcollection to the Selden Society Publications and the History of Early English Law database, at no additional cost to subscribers!
