




Google Single Sign-On

Sign in with Google Single Sign-On

- Link your Google and MyHein accounts right from MyHein.

- Google will automatically log you in to your MyHein as soon as you enter HeinOnline.

- Never interrupt your research flow again!



Manage Author Alerts

With HeinOnline's author profile pages, users have long been able to set up email alerts for particular authors.

Users can enter their email to set up desired alert(s) for the following:

- When new material for an author is added to HeinOnline
- When new articles in HeinOnline cite that author's articles
- When that author's articles are accessed each month
- When articles are published that are similar to that author's works
- When new cases in HeinOnline cite that author's articles – **new!**
