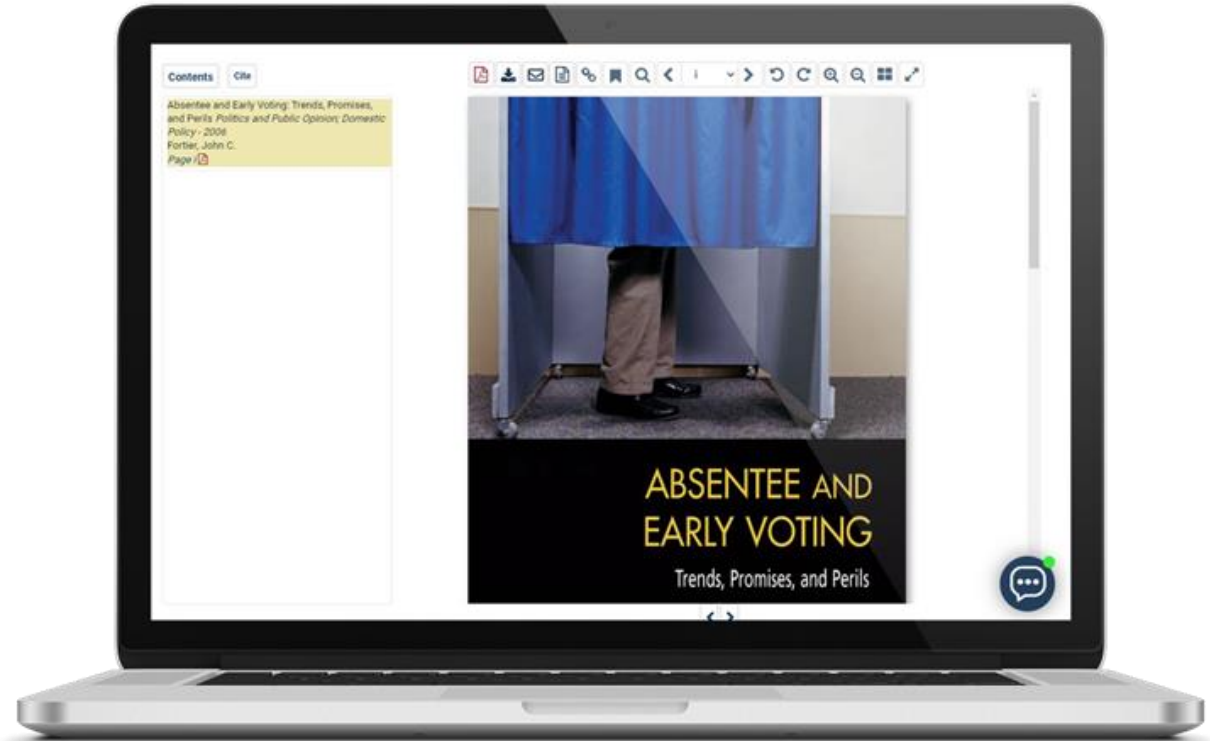

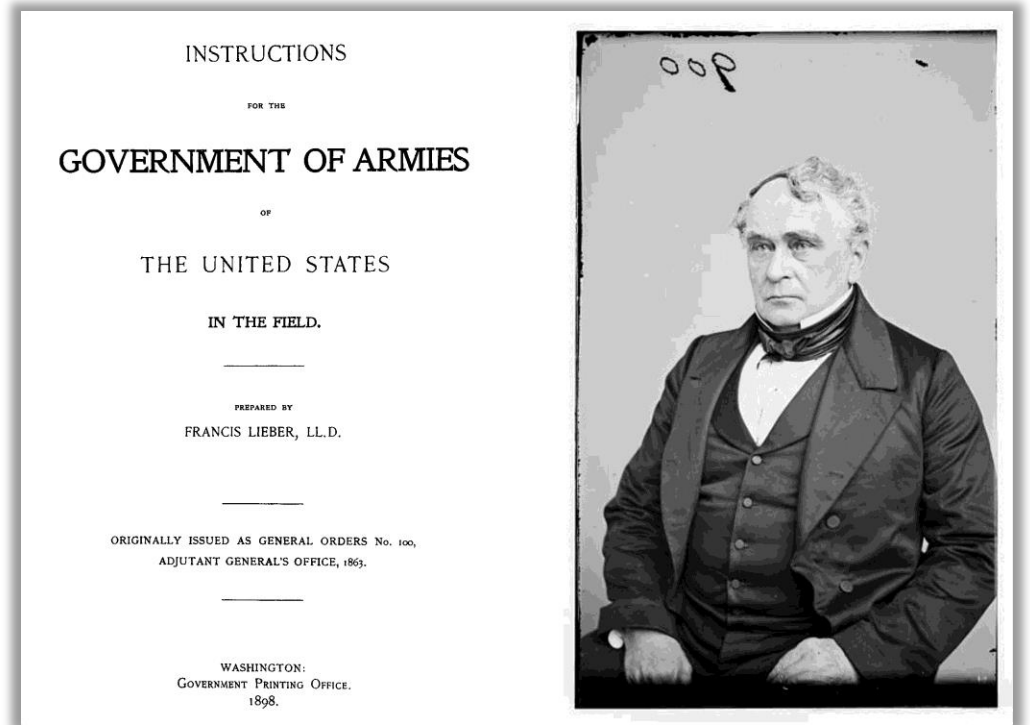

Landmark Cases

<p>Commonwealth v. Hunt, 1842 Declared labor unions are legal.</p> <p>In re Debs, 1895 The federal government's injunction to end the Pullman Strike was legal. It was the first time an injunction was used to break a strike. Eugene Debs, president of the American Railway Union, was arrested and tried for violating the injunction.</p> <p>Vegelehan v. Guntner, 1896 The Massachusetts Supreme Court ruled that striking workers were interfering with the right of an employer to hire. Today, the case is most famous for its dissent by Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr.</p> <p>Lochner v. New York, 1905 Invalidated a New York state law that capped bakers' workweek to 60 hours. It is famous for Justice Oliver Wendell Holmes' dissent. The "Lochner era" refers to the forty years when the Supreme Court tended to strike down laws regulating working conditions, wages, or hours.</p> <p>Loewe v. Lawlor, 1908 Also known as the "Danbury Hatters Case." Labor unions are subject to antitrust laws. Unions were later exempted from antitrust injunctions under the Norris-La Guardia Act in 1932 and the exemptions were upheld in <i>United States v. Hutcheson</i> (1941).</p> <p>Adair v. United States, 1908 Bans on yellow-dog contracts are unconstitutional. Yellow-dog contracts forbid employees from joining a union.</p>	<p>National Labor Relations Board v. Hearst Publications, 1944 Newsboys are "employees" under the definition of the National Labor Relations Act, not independent contractors.</p> <p>Griggs v. Duke Power Co., 1971 Generally considered the first case of its type, the case concerned whether an employer's policies violated Title VII by preventing Black employees from being hired and promoted.</p> <p>McDonnell Douglas Corp. v. Green, 1973 Created the framework for deciding Title VII employment discrimination cases.</p> <p>Alexander v. Gardner-Denver Co., 1974 Arbitration does not prevent an employee from bringing a Title VII claim.</p> <p>Geduldig v. Aiello, 1974 Denial of insurance benefits for work loss resulting from pregnancy does not violate the 14th Amendment.</p> <p>National Labor Relations Board v. J. Weingarten, Inc., 1975 Employees have the right to have a union representative present during an investigative interview that could lead to disciplinary action. Established so-called "Weingarten Rights."</p>

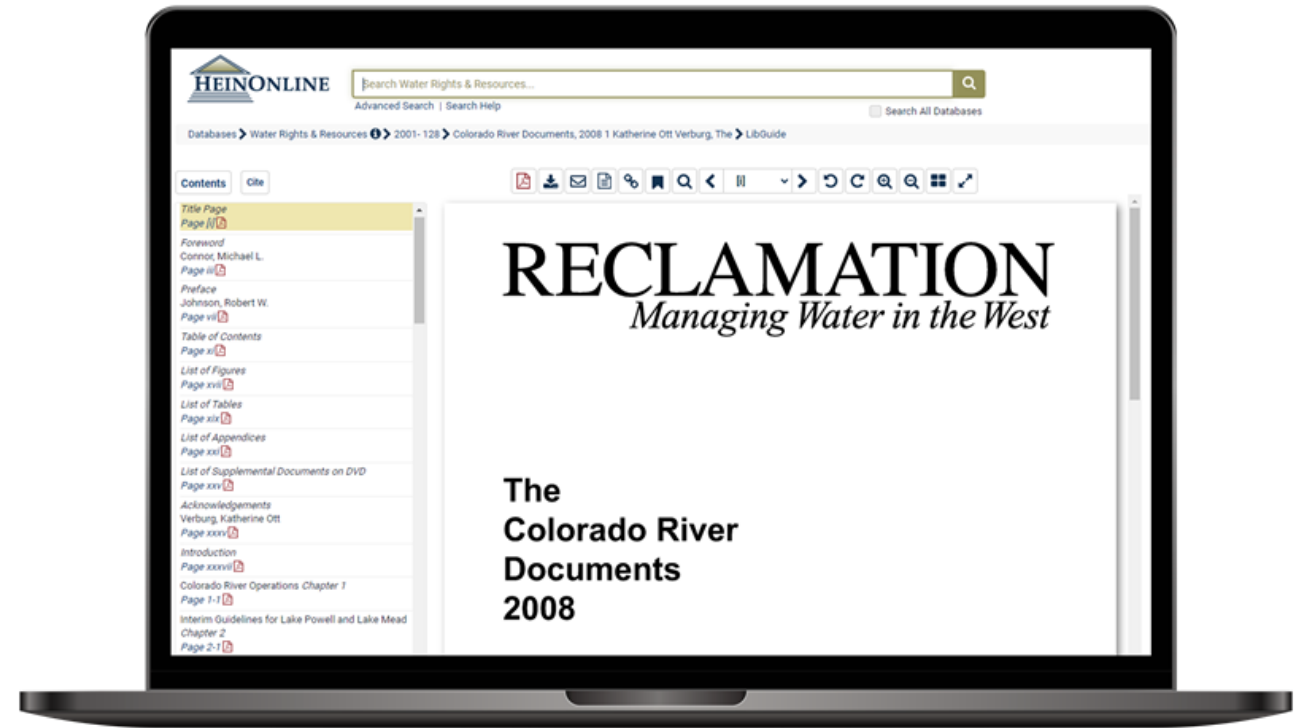

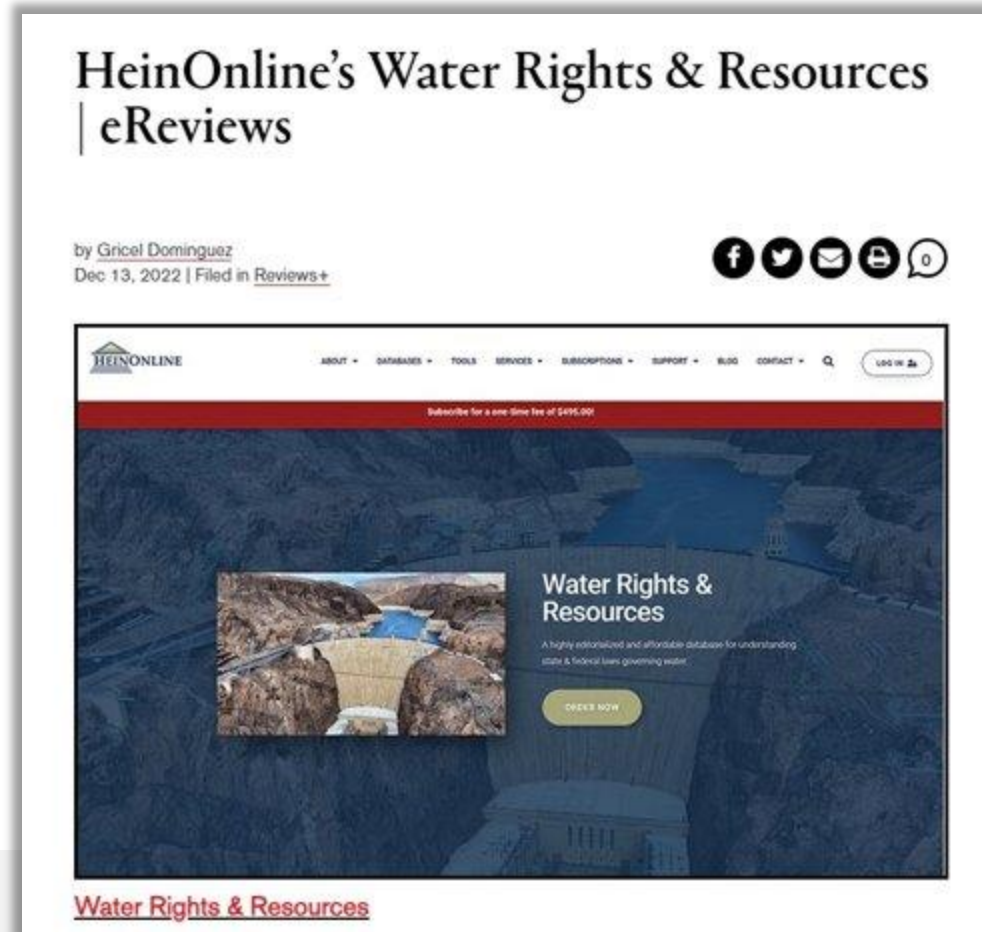

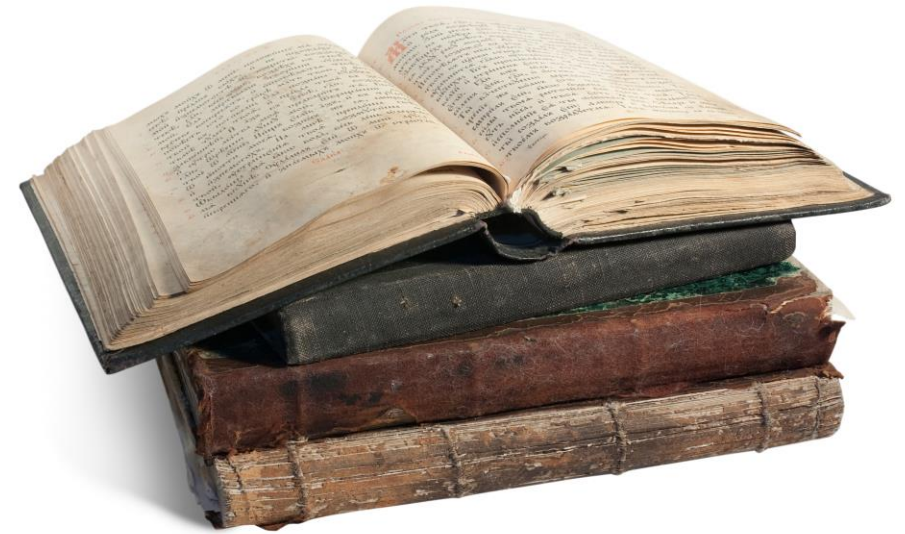

THE PUBLICATIONS ARE USUALLY NAMED AFTER THE REPORTER WHO WROTE THEM, HENCE, "NOMINATIVE."

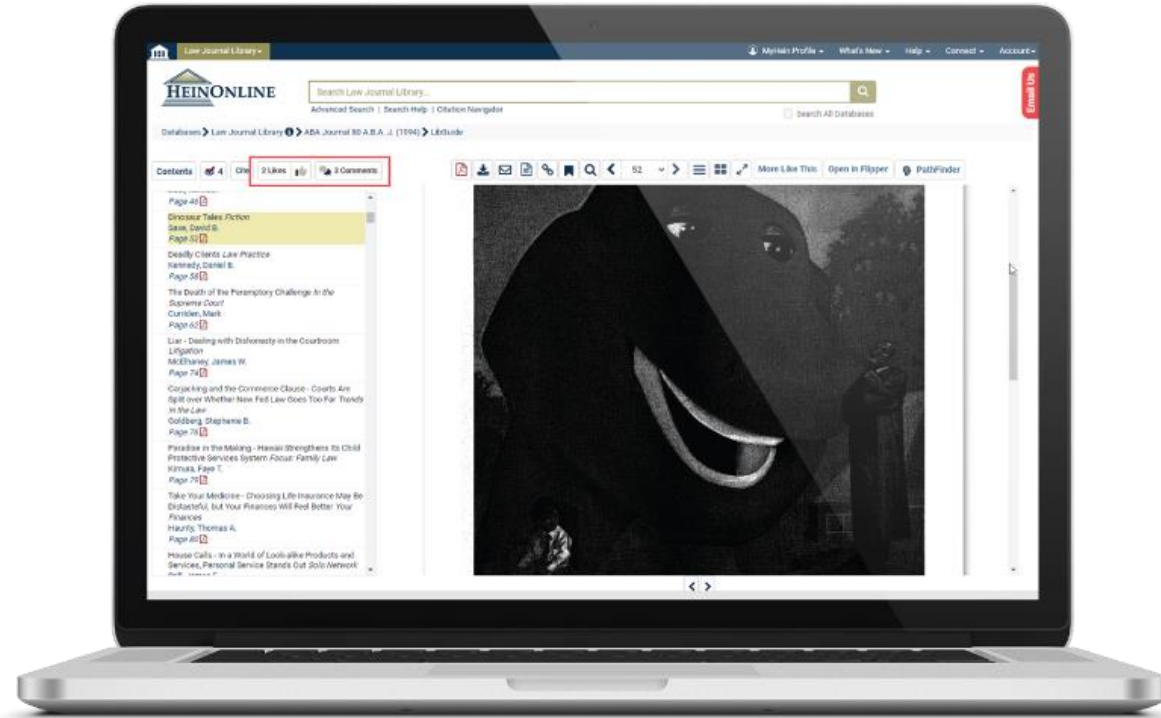
