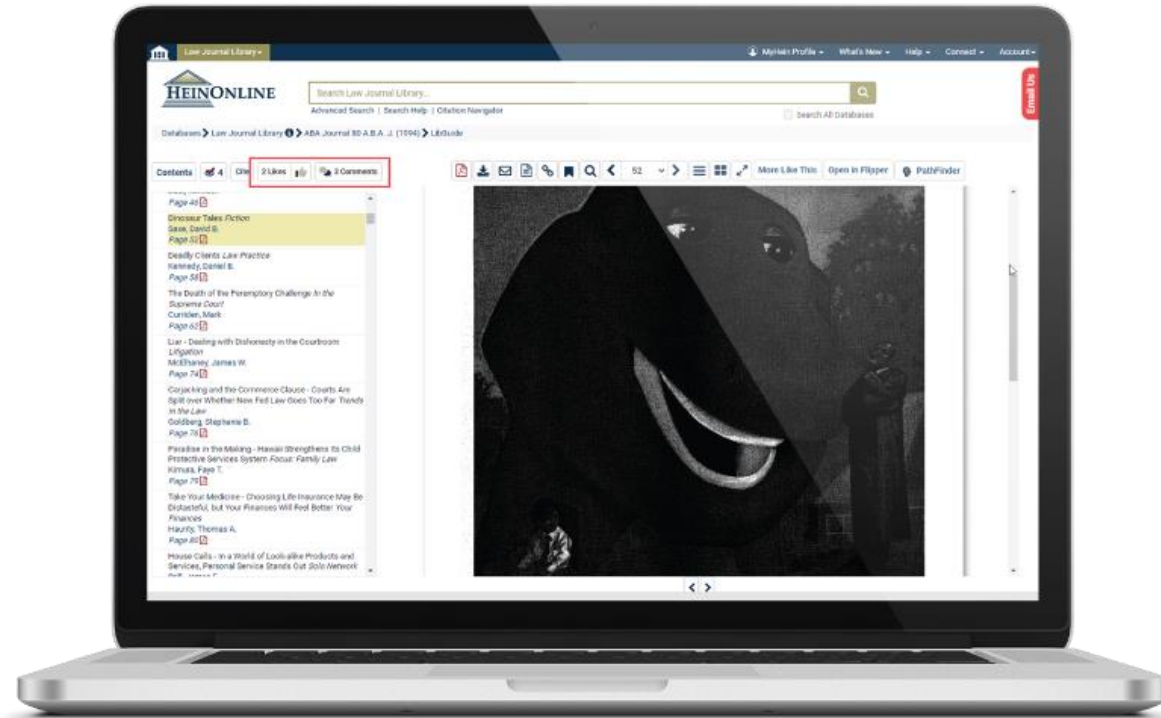

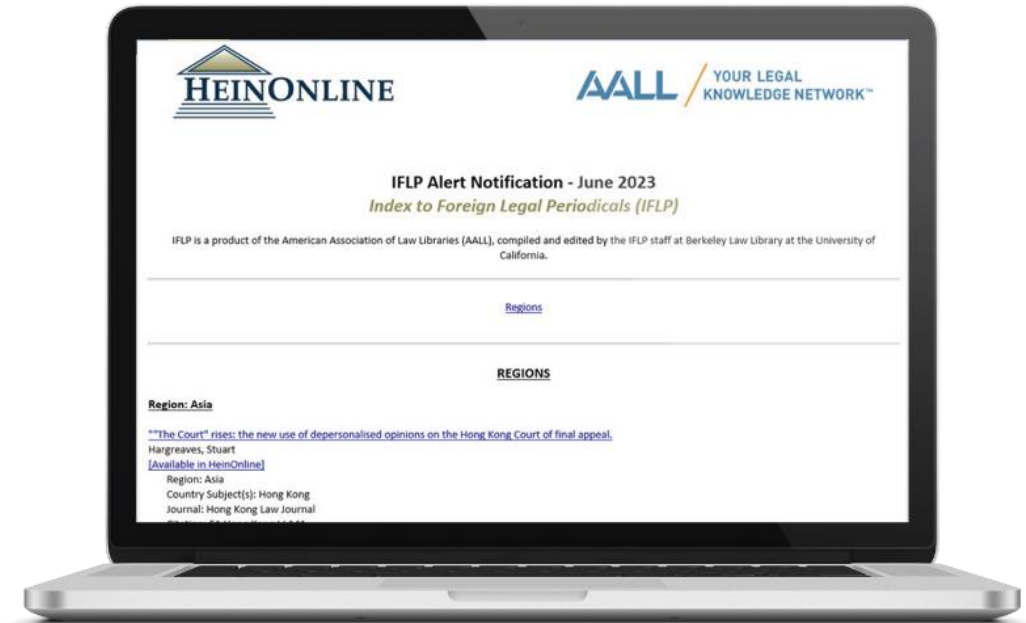

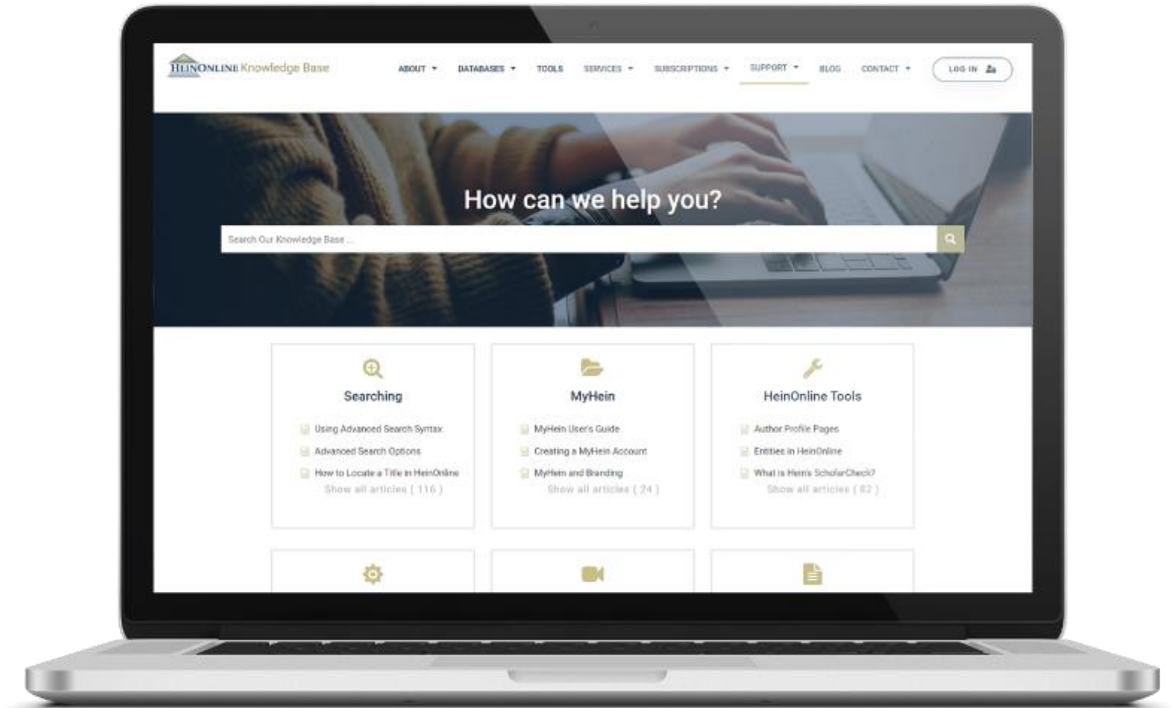


## WHAT IS KBART?

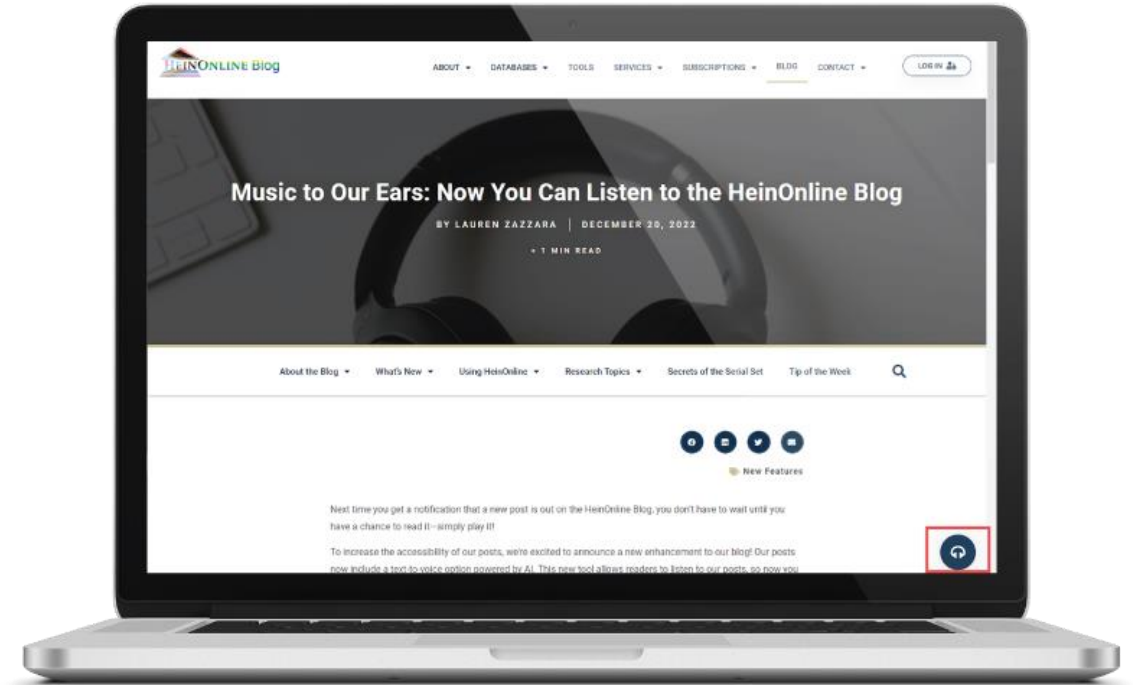
In short, it helps ensure that all the correct data is in place for HeinOnline's content to be accessible and discoverable within libraries.
