

Jan. 27, 2022

Retirement of Justice Stephen Breyer announced.

Feb. 25, 2022

President Biden announces that he will nominate Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson.

Feb. 28, 2022

President Biden sends Judge Jackson's nomination to the Senate.

Mar. 21, 2022

Senate Judiciary Committee Hearings on Judge Jackson's nomination begin.

Mar. 24, 2022

Senate Judiciary Committee Hearings conclude.

Apr. 4, 2022

Senate votes 53-47 to advance Judge Jackson's nomination in a Senate procedural vote.

Apr. 7, 2022

Senate confirms Judge Jackson's nomination, 53-47.

June 30, 2022

Justice Jackson sworn in as a member of the Supreme Court.
