Database 1: English Nominative Reports

HeinOnline's collection of reports spans more than 250 reporters across a more than 300-year timespan, from 1585 to 1899. Among these reporters are those most acclaimed—Plowden, Coke, Dyer, etc.—as well as those lesser known.



Database 2: Irish Nominative Reports

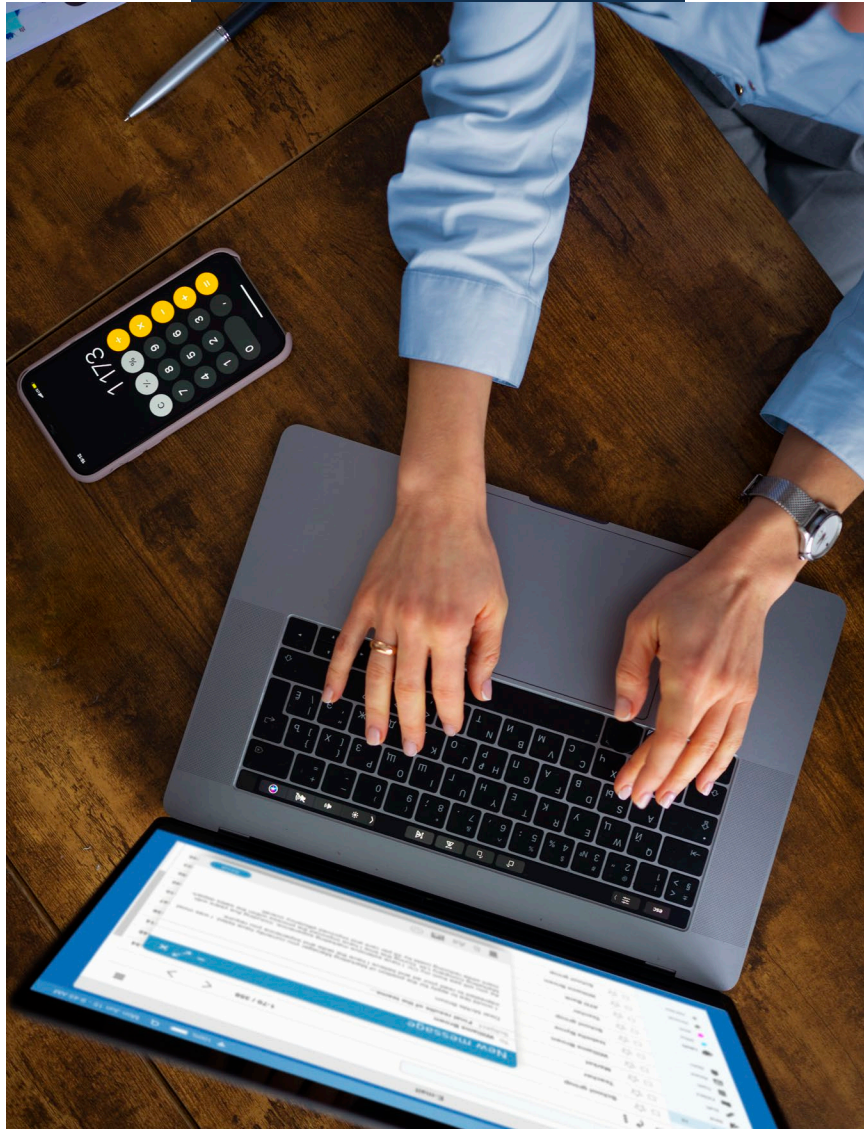
