## Law Journal Library

Contains more than 2,800 law and law-related periodicals. Coverage is from the first issue published for all periodicals and goes through the most-currently published issues allowed based on contracts with publishers. Search by article title, author, subject, state or country published, full text, and narrow by date.

## Canada Supreme Court Reports

HeinOnline's Canada Supreme Court Reports contains the official bilingual series published under authority of the Supreme Court Act. This collection includes more than 10,000 cases which include background information, statutes and regulations, authors cited, analysis and the decision.

## Code of Federal Regulations/Federal Register\*

The Federal Register is updated on a daily basis. Its coverage is comprehensive and begins from inception (1936). The CFR is also included from inception (1938), along with the Official US Bulletin (1917-1919), United States Government Manual from inception (1935), and Daily and Weekly Compilations of Presidential Documents from inception (1965).

## COVID-19 in America: Response, Issues & Law - *New*

Find factual information about how COVID-19 has impacted public health, economics, society, and the world. Access hundreds of Congressional Research Service (CRS) and Government Accountability Office (GAO) reports, updated regularly as this fluctuating situation evolves.

## Criminal Justice & Criminology

In addition, multiple navigation tools, such as a Case Locator, Chart Tool, and an Advanced Search feature enhance the ease of access to specific cases. Also included in this collection is the Statutes of the Realm (1235-1713), along with Pre-1865 Law Reports.

## Revised Statutes of Canada

Complete coverage of all six revisions from the official printed volumes of the Revised Statutes of Canada in nearly 48,000 pages.

## Slavery in America and the World: History, Culture & Law

This HeinOnline collection brings together a multitude of essential legal materials on slavery in the United States and the English-speaking world. ## U.S. Federal Legislative History Library

Researchers should begin their U.S. federal legislative history research with this finding aid, which often includes references to law review articles on-point to a particular legislative history.

## U.S. Presidential Impeachment Library - *New*
