Revised Statutes of Canada

This database compiles all the federal laws of Canada since Confederation in 1867. It includes the periodic consolidation of the Statutes of Canada, incorporating amendments and Acts that have been added since the last revision. There were six revisions: 1886, 1906, 1927, 1952, 1970, and 1985.
