

Logging In



Click the IP Authentication button, if authorized by an organization. Alternatively, log in with a HeinOnline username and password.

Accessing Content



After logging in, users will see a list of their subscribed collections. Select any library name to open and view the contents of that library.

Title Lookup




After selecting a library, enter a publication title. Type the name of the journal or publication using quotations to enclose the phrase.

Navigating




From inside a library, the **Search** option is available at the top of the page. A **Citation Navigator** option can be found below the **Search** bar for databases with the feature (i.e. Law Journal Library).

Searching



Click **Search** at the top of the page to begin. This search box allows for advanced searching, so utilize advanced search syntax. As with all searching in HeinOnline, be sure to use quotes around phrases.

Citation Navigator



Click **Citation Navigator** at the top of the home screen. When entering the citation abbreviation, a list will appear below. Click the citation, enter the volume and page number, and click "Get Citation."

iOS and Android Versions Available

Both iOS and Android users can access the world's largest image-based academic and legal research database from their mobile device. Using the app, browse database and title lists or search for documents using the full power of advanced searching. Users can view image-based PDFs, download the PDFs to their device, or email them to a colleague or classmate.
