DATABASES INCLUDED IN THE PACKAGE

American Enterprise Institute

This database brings AEI's collection of scholarship to HeinOnline's fully searchable image-based format. Browse titles in HeinOnline by Policy Area or use the facets under Refine Your Search. Easily search the full text of all publications, including titles that have not yet been released by the AEI.

Bremer-Kovacs Collection: Historic Documents Related to the Administrative Procedure Act of 1946

This comprehensive database is designed to make the APA's history more accessible and understandable. The database is rounded out with various tools to help researchers navigate the database, understand the documents in their rich historical context, and quickly identify the material most relevant to the user's precise interests. A comprehensive timeline charting the Act's passage is also included.

Canada Supreme Court Reports

This database contains the official, bilingual series published under authority of the Supreme Court Act. This database includes more than 10,000 cases which include background information, statutes and regulations, authors cited, analysis and the decisions.

Civil Rights and Social Justice

This database brings together a diverse offering of publications covering civil rights in the United States as their legal protections and definitions are expanded to cover more and more Americans.

Code of Federal Regulations

The Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) is the codification of the general and permanent rules and regulations (sometimes called administrative law) published in the Federal Register by the executive departments and agencies of the federal government of the United States.

CourtListener (U.S. State & Federal Case Law)

Explore a vast collection of U.S. state & federal case law through HeinOnline's integration with CourtListener. Case law may be accessed seamlessly via citation lookup or inline hyperlinking within documents that cite the case. Coverage includes 99% of all precedential legal case law published in the United States.

COVID-19: Pandemics Past and Present

This database contains publications on the various ways COVID-19 has impacted every aspect of life, from testing issues in the medical field to unemployment and economic impact. This database, much like our understanding of COVID-19, will continue to evolve as new content is published and integrated with regular updates. Importantly, this collection also features subcollections dedicated to Past Pandemics, and Vaccinations.

Criminal Justice & Criminology

This collection offers an historical overview of how criminal justice has changed in American and English law and the effect criminology has had in facilitating those changes. English Reports

Reports of U.S. Presidential Commissions

U.S. Code

This database includes complete coverage of the U.S. Code dating back to inception in 1925-1926. Also includes the Early Federal Laws Collection, which represents the most complete collection of federal statute compilations prior to the U.S. Code.

U.S. Congressional Documents

This database features the complete Congressional Record Bound version, as well as the daily version back to 1980. It also includes the three predecessor titles: Annals of Congress (1789-1824), Register of Debates (1824-1837), and Congressional Globe (1833-1873), Congressional Hearings (early 1900s-present) and other important congressional material. Using the Daily-to-Bound Locator Tool, you can quickly find a page in the Bound volume from the Daily edition.

U.S. Congressional Serial Set

The United States Congressional Serial Set is considered an essential publication for unveiling American history. Spanning more than two centuries with more than 17,000 bound volumes, the records in this series include House & Senate Reports and Documents, and more.

U.S. Federal Legislative History Library
