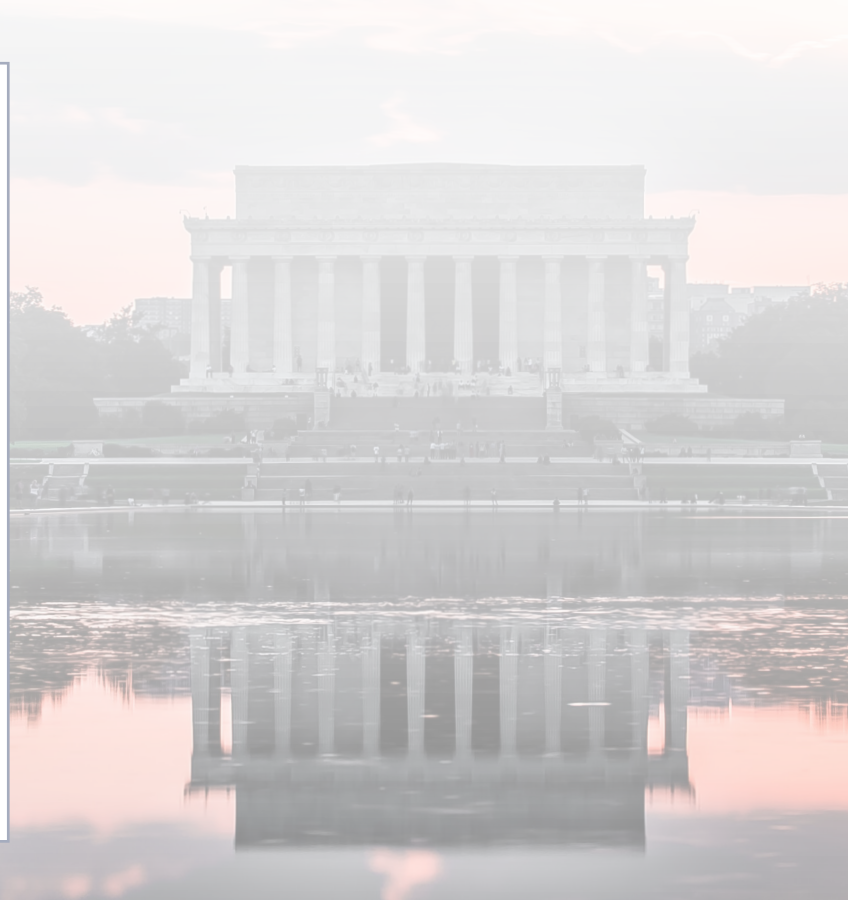

About the U.S. Presidential Impeachment Library

"The President, Vice President, and all civil Officers of the United States, shall be removed from Office on Impeachment for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, and other high Crimes and Misdemeanors." — **U.S. Constitution, Article II, Section 4**

Impeachment proceedings in the United States are rare. Presidential impeachments are even rarer. Since 1789, the House of Representatives has initiated impeachment proceedings only 62 times, and just 19 of these have led to full impeachments. Eight federal judges have been convicted and removed from office by the Senate, but thus far no president has met the same ignominious fate.

Yet despite its rarity, presidential impeachment is arguably what we associate most closely with the broader topic of impeachment. The names popular history most often links to impeachment are not West Hughes Humphreys, a United States District Judge from Tennessee impeached for supporting the Confederacy, or Mark W. Delahay, a District of Kansas judge who was impeached in 1873 on charges of drunkenness. Instead, popular memory pairs three (and now four) U.S. Presidents with impeachment.

Messages and Papers of the Presidents

This 22-volume set beginning with George Washington and concluding with Herbert Hoover contains the messages of the presidents of the United States annual, veto, and special. These messages are among the most interesting, instructive, and valuable contributions to the public literature of our republic. They discuss from the loftiest standpoint nearly all the great questions of national policy and many subjects of minor interest which have engaged the attention of the people from the beginning of our history, and so constitute important and often vital links in their progressive development.

Public Papers of the Presidents

Public Papers of the Presidents begins with Herbert Hoover and concludes with Barack Obama. The papers have been compiled and published by the Office of the Federal Register's National Archives and Records Administration since 1957 in response to a recommendation by the National Historical Publications Commission. Noting the lack of uniform compilations of messages and papers of the presidents before this time, the Commission recommended the establishment of an official series in which presidential writings, address, and remarks of a public nature would be made available.

Daily Compilation of Presidential Documents

The *Daily Compilation of Presidential Documents* is issued through the Office of the Federal Register and contains statements, messages, and other presidential material released by the White House. This compilation also includes speeches, press conferences, press releases, proclamations, executive orders, acts approved by the president, and many more documents. Also included is the predecessor title, *Weekly Compilation of Presidential Documents*.

Code of Federal Regulations, Title 3: Presidents

This series contains the full text of presidential proclamations, executive orders, and various other presidential documents promulgated from 1936 to current.


