## **Periodical Indexes**

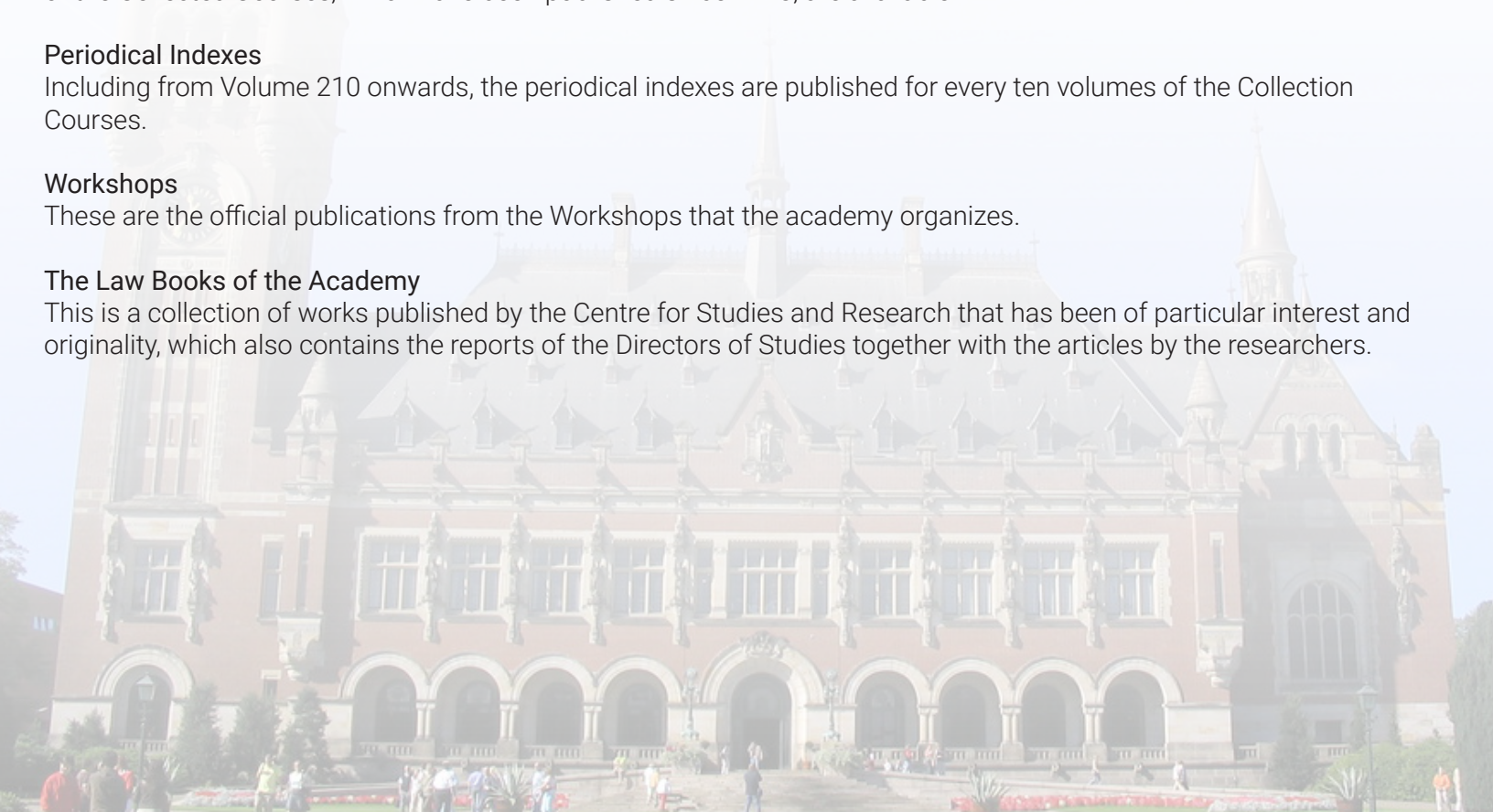
Including from Volume 210 onwards, the periodical indexes are published for every ten volumes of the Collection Courses.
