We offer 24 hour, 48 hour, or 1 week subscriptions to individuals for select HeinOnline databases. Subscriptions are purchased using PayPal and are limited to 5 downloads per 24 hours. There is a 200 page limit per PDF download. Pricing varies per collection.

This database contains more than 2,500 law and law-related periodicals and covers subjects such as criminal justice, political science, technology, human rights and more. The coverage for all journals is from inception and goes through the most currently published issue allowed based on contracts with publishers. About 90% of journals are available through the current issue or volume. Users can search by article, title, author subject, state or country published, full text, and narrow by date.

Therefore, please review the available content to ensure the material you wish to access is included in the database. 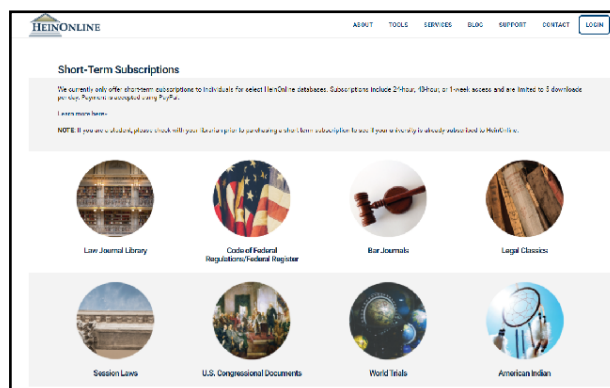
## Federal Register & Code of Federal Regulations
